



WAIPAPA PINE UNTREATED NO.2 FRAMING AND BOX GRADE TIMBER

PURPOSE

Waipapa Pine Untreated No.2 Framing and Box Grade Timber can be used for both non-structural and structural purposes as:

- > external temporary concrete boxing and structural formwork to support self-weight, vertical loads, and horizontal pressures from wet, self-compacting concrete, and
- > wall and roof framing (including trusses) protected from the weather, in unlined and unoccupied farm buildings and outbuildings.

The timber (also known as Cut of Log) can also be used for general purpose uses such as pallets, boxing and bins.

EXPLANATION

Waipapa Pine Untreated No.2 Framing and Box Grade Timber is a utility-grade timber manufactured from sustainably sourced New Zealand plantation radiata pine.

Waipapa Pine Untreated No.2 Framing and Box Grade Timber is rough sawn and available in the following dimensions (mm):

75 x 50, 100 x 50, 150 x 50, 200 x 50, 250 x 50, 300 x 50 and 100 x 25 and 150 x 25.

SCOPE AND LIMITATIONS OF USE

Scope Limitations

Location

In wind zones up to and including extra high as defined in NZS 3604:2011 or specifically designed in accordance with AS/NZS 1170.0:2002.

In any seismic or snow zone.

Building

Where the balance of the primary structure complies with the relevant provisions of the NZS Building Code or in the case of an existing building, where the designer has established it is suitable for the intended building work.

As temporary structural formwork.

- ➤ Waipapa Pine Untreated No.2 Framing and Box Grade Timber must be installed in accordance with NZS 3109:1997 and NZS 3604:2011 (sections 6,7, and 9) for strip foundations and foundation pads.
- Lateral bracing in the form of forms and shores should be used to retain alignment and resist all lateral loads.
- > The building must be unlined.
- The building must not be used for purposes involving high humidity or moisture such as saunas, spa pools or agricultural purposes where there is elevated moisture content conducive to decay.

As wall and roof framing (including trusses) protected from the weather, in unlined and unoccupied farm buildings and outbuildings.
